Carolina Criminal Justice Training and Standards Commission in November, 2000. I am currently assigned as a Detective with the Criminal Investigations Division of the Cary Police Department. Prior to my assignment as a Detective, I investigated and arrested individuals regarding numerous incidents of breaking and entering to businesses and residences, larceny offenses, possession of stolen property and traffic offenses as an officer assigned to the Field Operations Bureau of both the Cary Police Department and the Greensboro Police Department. Since my assignment as a Detective in January, 2005, I have investigated and arrested individuals regarding the criminal offenses of attempted murder, assault with a deadly weapon with the intent to kill, armed robbery, rape, sex offenses, financial crimes and drug crimes. I have more than 1,400 hours of law enforcement training which includes advanced training in the investigation of natural deaths, suicides and homicides.

B. On Saturday, July 12, 2008, the Cary Police Department initiated an investigation regarding a 'missing person', Nancy Lynn Cooper, who was last seen at the residence of 104 Wallsburg Court, Cary, N.C. which she shared with her husband, Bradley (Brad) Graham Cooper and their two (2) children.

On Monday, July 14, 2008, a body was located by a resident of Wake County, North Carolina lying face down in a 'drainage pond' in an undeveloped phase within 'The Oaks at Meadowridge' subdivision, which is located in close proximity to the 4700 Block of Fielding Drive, Raleigh, North Carolina in Wake County and reported to the Wake County Sheriff's Office. The body was determined to be that of a white female, who was deceased. The deceased white female had died as a result of 'suspicious circumstances' based upon a joint investigation by the Wake County Sheriff's Office, the Cary Police Department, the City-County Bureau of Identification (Wake County) and the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner.

On Tuesday, July 15, 2008, the deceased white female was identified as Nancy Lynn Cooper by Dr. John Butts, the Chief Medical Examiner for the State of North Carolina. The manner of death was determined to be a homicide based upon the autopsy by Dr. Butts.

During interviews with numerous friends, to include Jessica Adam and Diana Duncan, Cary Police Detective G. Daniels, Cary Police Detective A. Dismukes and affiant learned

that Nancy Cooper was seeking a divorce from Brad Cooper due to an admission of an extramarital affair with another female.

During contact with Cary Police Officer D. Hayes on July 12, 2008, Brad Cooper provided Officer Hayes with two (2) address books and a cell phone, all of which Brad Cooper identified as being the property of Nancy Cooper, to assist regarding the 'missing person' investigation pertaining to Nancy Cooper. These items were retained and reviewed by Detective Dismukes, Detective Daniels and affiant to gain information pertinent to the 'missing person' investigation. On July 15, 2008, these items were deemed to be evidence regarding the homicide investigation pertaining to Nancy Cooper.

During the initial review and examination of the two (2) address books, it was noted that Nancy Cooper had entered information in both of these items and there were numerous pieces of loose paper documents and writings which appeared to have been placed within the address books by Nancy Cooper. This affiant believes that this information may be relevant to the homicide investigation since all entries and writings appear to be completed solely by Nancy Cooper based upon the handwriting style and characteristics being consistent with known writings by Nancy Cooper.

The cell phone belonging to Nancy Cooper was 'locked' when it was provided to Officer Hayes by Brad Cooper. During the course of the investigation, Detective Dismukes, Detective Daniels and affiant have learned that Nancy Cooper kept her cell phone 'locked' to keep information confidential due to the separation/divorce of Nancy and Brad Cooper. In addition, it was learned that Nancy Cooper kept her cell phone with her at all times.

Based on the above information provided in this affidavit, the affiant requests that a search warrant be issued to search the property items detailed under 'Section III: Description of Items to be Searched' for the property items listed under 'Section I: Description of Property to be Seized' to seek evidence regarding the homicide of Nancy Lynn Cooper.
