The affiant has been employed with the Wake County Sheriff's Office for 11 ½ years. I am currently assigned to the Wake County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division Person Crimes Unit. This unit is primarily responsible for investigating all death investigations, particularly murder. I am a North Carolina State Certified Criminal Justice instructor and have also obtained my Advanced Certification in Law Enforcement Training.

On Tuesday, December 2, 2008 at 9:33pm the Wake County Sheriff's Office responded to 4221 Olive Branch Lane pursuant to a request from the Apex Police Department to attempt locating a missing person. Responding deputies arrived on the scene and located a deceased male inside the residence. The deceased appeared to be a young, white male contained in a plastic bag with duct tape over his mouth. It was unknown at the time if the deceased male found inside the residence was in fact the missing person. Officers from the Apex Police Department were able to locate and interview several people whom they believe could identify the deceased and also provide additional information in this case. One person who Apex Police interviewed subsequently confessed to participating in the death of the deceased, along with three other co-conspirators. The witness admitted to beating the deceased on his head with a hammer, tying the deceased with zip ties, suffocating him with duct tape and disposing of him in a plastic bag. The witness also stated they attempted to utilize medications commonly used for animals to plan the murder and read the deceased his fortune using tarot cards just prior to his death. One of the co-conspirators who confessed also identified a subject who resides at 107 Woolard Way as having participated in the crimes as well. Investigators with the Wake County Sheriff's




