Probable Cause Affidavit

I, Detective TP Hughes, have been a Law Enforcement Officer with the Raleigh Police Department for over fifteen years. I am currently assigned to the Investigative Division – Southwest District. Over the last fifteen years, I have investigated numerous offenses involving violations of NC Law which have resulted in the arrest and convictions for said violations. I have received training through the Raleigh Police Academy and the North Carolina Justice Academy in the enforcement of violations of NC Law and this training has been updated through In- Service training sessions.

On 04-08-2009, at approximately 1030 pm, uniformed officers of the Raleigh Police Department responded to the intersection of Parrott Drive and Park Place in regards to a single vehicle crash involving the above mentioned vehicle. Emergency Management Services arrived on scene and determined that the loan occupant of the vehicle was deceased. There was a large amount of blood throughout the interior portion of the vehicle which was inconsistent with the level of the crash the vehicle was involved in. A more in depth search of the deceased revealed lacerations to the deceased throat and chest also inconsistent with the crash.

Based on my training and experience, it is my opinion that the cause of death resulted from the criminal act of murder. A search of the vehicle is needed to ensure the proper and true identification of the deceased person as well as to search for evidence related as indicated in the property to be seized section in this probable cause affidavit. A search of the vehicle will hopefully produce evidence that may identify the suspect/s in this investigation.
