PROPERTY TO BE SEIZED:

Any and all paper correspondence to include but not limited to letters and envelopes addressed to Eric Chambers.

LOCATION TO BE SEARCHED:

The location to be searched is a jail cell located inside the Wake County Jail, 330 S. Salisbury St Raleigh N.C. 27602. Through computer records and jail staff, Eric Chambers cell is identifiable as 9 yellow 10.

FACTS TO ESTABLISH PROBABLE CAUSE:

1. I, S Selvek, have been a duly sworn law enforcement officer in Garner for the past eleven years. I have been employed with the Garner Police Department since 1997. I am currently assigned to the Drugs and Vice Unit. I have received specialized training in the area of criminal investigations and have 1800 hours of Law Enforcement related training. This training was conducted through numerous Community Colleges, the North Carolina Justice Academy, and numerous Federal Agencies. As a result of this training, I am familiar the numerous areas of Law Enforcement and utilize the knowledge to investigate criminal acts.

Since being a Garner Police Investigator, April 2004, I have also investigated murders, rapes, robberies, assault cases, other criminal cases, and some of these cases resulted in arrests and convictions.

2. On 11-14-08 around 2217 hours, Officers with the Garner Police Department discovered the body of a deceased child located at 1852 Spring Drive Garner N.C. 27529. The apartment is leased to Sherita McNeil, the mother of the deceased child. Through investigative means it was discovered that the utilities to that location were in the name of Eric Chambers, the father of the deceased child. The child was found in a white plastic garbage bag, in a plastic container with sheets on top, and the sheets had bleach poured on them to mask the smell. This container was located in the bedroom closet of Sherita McNeil. The child had not been seen by family members for over a month. The mother told family members that the child was staying with a close family friend when, in fact, the child was not.

3. Letters from Eric Chambers to Sherita McNeil were found inside the apartment located at 1852 Spring Drive, Garner N.C. In the letters, Chambers repeatedly threatens Sherita and her other baby's father. He also expresses concern about Sherita getting rid of their son, the deceased child. His letters are written in a manner that would indicate the letters he is receiving from Sherita will have information about the deceased child and Sherita's intentions with the child.

4. Based on the information listed above, (This information was corroborated by the police investigation into the suspicious death of DeVarion Gross and other related computer files). There is probable cause to search, Wake County Jail cell 9 yellow 10, located inside the Wake County Jail, 330 S. Salisbury St. Raleigh N.C. 27602 for the listed items. I request that this SEARCH WARRANT be issued so I may investigate this matter.
