Contributions are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. North Carolina law allows any individual or registered political action committee to contribute up to \$4,000 per election. Corporate contributions, contributions from registered lobbyists, and contributions from foreign nationals are prohibited. NC law also requires name, mailing address, job title or profession, and name of the employer for individuals contributing in excess of \$50 in an election to be reported. This committee cannot accept contributions from lobbyists and are not asking for such. We are providing you with a copy of this information simply to inform you and request that you pass the information along to any interested parties and recommend support where appropriate. This committee cannot accept contributions from Political Action Committees while the NC General Assembly is in Session.
